
User Manual

Smart 3D Standing Fan



READ AND SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS WARNING

Failure to comply with the warnings listed below may result in electric shock or serious injury.

This product should be used only in accordance with the specifications outlined in this manual. Usage other than what has been specified here may result in serious injury.

- Please ensure to read and understand the complete user manual before using the fan.
- The fan is only suitable for specified power types and voltages. Do not use a power source that does not match the specifications.
- Ensure the fan is switched off and unplug the power cord before use.
- Place the fan on a stable, dry surface, away from flammable materials and water sources.
- Position the fan in a well-ventilated area to ensure proper airflow and prevent overheating.
- Before cleaning or servicing the fan, always disconnect the power and wait for it to completely stop running.
- Avoid inserting fingers, or other objects, into moving parts of the fan.
- If any abnormal noise, odor, or other issues are noticed with the fan, immediately discontinue use and contact customer service.
- Do not place heavy objects on the fan or block airflow to ensure normal operation and performance.
- When the fan is not in use for an extended period, unplug the power cord and store it in a safe location.
- Do not expose the fan to direct sunlight or high temperatures to prevent damage or deformation.
- When cleaning the fan, use a soft cloth or brush and avoid using corrosive or abrasive cleaners.
- Regularly check the fan's power cord and plug for any damage and replace if necessary.
- Avoid splashing water or other liquids into the interior of the fan to prevent electric shock or circuit damage.

• When using the fan, do not obstruct the airflow or place it in confined spaces to ensure sufficient ventilation.

- For prolonged use of the fan, regularly inspect its operation and clean it from dust as needed.
- If the fan surface becomes wet or damp, disconnect it from the power source and allow it to completely dry before the next use.
- Place the fan in a location away from children and pets to prevent accidental contact or injury.
- For repairs or replacing fan components, please contact a professional or authorized service center.

• The appliance is not to be used by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction. (IEC)

CHARGING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. 2600mAh rechargeable lithium battery.
- 2. Using adaptor to quickly charge.
- 3. When the battery is charged from 0% to 25%, the first light on the left is on.


When the battery is charged from 25% to 50%, the second indicator lights up.


When the battery is charged from 50% to 75%, the third indicator lights up.

When the battery is from 75% to 100%, all four indicator lights are on.




Please follow the steps below for fan installation. To disassemble and store, simply follow the steps in reverse.

•Download and install the "Smart Life" App on your smartphone or tablet. Create your

account and log in.

•WiFi Configuration via Mode Button:

To initiate the WiFi configuration, press and hold the mode button for a few seconds.

•Starting or Resetting WiFi Connection:

Press and hold the mode button for 2 seconds to start or reset the WiFi connection. The indicator light

will begin to flash, signaling that the device is ready for connection. Upon successful connection, the

light will turn solid white.

•Automatic and Manual WiFi Configuration:

First time holding (Automatic Configuration): The indicator light will flash quickly (once every 300ms)


to indicate that the device is in automatic WiFi configuration mode.

Second time holding (Manual Configuration): The indicator light will flash slowly (once every second)

to indicate that the device is in manual WiFi configuration mode.


•Connection Timeout:

Cleaning & Maintenance

How to Clean



- \cdot ~ Use a screwdriver to loosen the bottom screws and remove the fan cover.
- · Rotate and lift the front cover to detach it.
- Sequentially disassemble the nut, fan blade, and back cover.
- \cdot Wipe or rinse the four parts shown in the picture. Ensure they are completely dry before reassembly and use.
- \cdot Clean the remaining fan components with a dry cloth, avoiding the use of water.
- \cdot The machine should be cleaned at least once every month. More frequent cleaning may be required depending on environmental conditions.
